



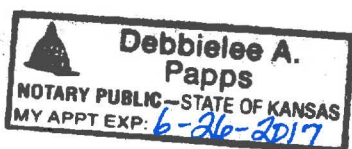
AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

Dear Mr. Matthews,

Here at Westar Energy, we greatly appreciate and value the opportunity to be your long-term electric service provider. In addition to providing safe, clean, reliable electricity, a key responsibility of ours involves periodic reviews of service territories. Therefore, we have recently partnered with Leavenworth-Jefferson Electric Cooperative (LJEC) and the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) to review service territory boundaries in your area.

So what does "service territory" mean? The Retail Electric Suppliers Act, passed by the Kansas legislature in 1976, mandated that only one electric supplier be assigned to a given geographic area, or service territory. The KCC approved geographic boundaries for each electric supplier in which only one supplier could provide electric service.

The recent review of territory boundaries mentioned above has determined your address is located in LJEC's service territory. Therefore, prior to KCC action, LJEC is currently the electric utility with the obligation to provide your electric service.

As a result of this territory review, LJEC and Westar have filed applications with the KCC to adjust the boundary at your location and grant Westar proper certificate authority to provide electric service at your address. We are providing this notice to inform you of the pending proceeding with the KCC, and our desire to retain your business.

Westar values you as a customer and wishes to continue serving you as we have for many years.
