## ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN AT&T AND MCC TELEPHONY

The above-captioned matter comes on before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission grants the application for approval of the interconnection agreement (ICA) between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Kansas (AT&T) and MCC Telephony of the Midwest, LLC (MCC and Application, respectively).

- 1. AT&T filed its Application on April 7, 2010. AT&T reported that MCC had adopted an ICA previously approved by the Commission on September 23, 2008, in Docket No. 08-SWBT-1135-IAT. AT&T further reported that there were no issues between it and MCC with regard to the adopted ICA.
- 2. AT&T noted that MCC's petition for a Certificate of Convenience (COC), filed December 28, 2009, had not yet been approved. However, AT&T requested the Commission consider this filing consistent with the outcome of MCC's pending COC.
- 3. AT&T requested that the Commission grant expeditious approval of the adopted ICA, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. AT&T

assured the Commission that the ICA was a bilateral agreement, reached as a result of

negotiation and compromise and the parties do not believe a docket or intervention by

other parties is necessary or appropriate.

4. The Commission has reviewed the Application and concludes that it should

approve same. However, MCC may not make use of the ICA, or operate in the State of

Kansas, until its petition for a COC is granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The Commission approves the application by AT&T for approval of the

interconnection agreement adopted by MCC.

B. The Commission cautions MCC that it may not use the adopted ICA, or

operate in the State of Kansas, until its petition for a COC is granted.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of

this docket for the purpose of issuing such additional orders as it deems necessary.
