ENTRY OF APPEARANCE OF KANSAS MUNICIPAL ENERGY AGENCY

Terri Pemberton hereby enters her appearance as counsel of record for and on behalf of Kansas Municipal Energy Agency (KMEA) in the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to the formula based ratemaking (FBR) plan protocols approved by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for Southern Pioneer Electric Company (Southern Pioneer) in Docket No. 19-SPEE-240-MIS (19-240 Docket) (the Southern Pioneer FBR Plan Protocols), “Signatories who were a party to the 19-SPEE-240-MIS docket will be considered automatically approved for intervention upon (1) the filing of an Entry of Appearance in any individual annual FBR Plan application filed during the five-year term of this plan, and (2) provided they are not prohibited from participation by statute or otherwise.”¹

The application filed by Southern Pioneer in this matter is one of the annual FBR Plan applications contemplated under the 19-240 Docket agreement.

KMEA was a signatory to the 19-240 Docket agreement, and is not otherwise prohibited by law from participating in this proceeding.
