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### **ORDER WITHDRAWING MOTION**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 17, 2017, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, assessing David Brandyberry, d/b/a B Bar K Tree Service (Tree Service) a civil penalty for violations of the Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations discovered during a compliance review on July 19, 2017, by Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator Penny Fryback.
- 2. On August 31, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Amending Penalty Order, reducing the civil penalty to \$100.
- 3. As of October 31, 2017, Tree Service had failed to comply with the requirements of the Commission's Order Amending Penalty Order, dated August 31, 2017.

- On November 3, 2017, Staff filed a Motion to Motion to Suspend Intrastate Motor
   Carrier Operations due to the Respondent's noncompliance with the Order Amending Penalty
   Order.
- 5. On November 4, 2017, Tree Service remitted the full \$100 civil penalty to the Transportation Division.
- 6. On November 6, 2017, Staff filed a Motion to Withdraw Motion to Suspend Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations due to Respondent's full compliance with the Order Amending Penalty Order.
- 7. Pursuant to Respondent's Payment and Staff's Motion, the Motion to Suspend Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations is withdrawn.

#### IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- (A) Staff's October 31, 2017 Motion to Suspend Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations, filed in this docket, is withdrawn.
- (B) The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).
- (C) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
