The State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) enters this Order to correct an error. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds as follows:

1. On November 2, 2011, the Commission issued an order in the above-captioned docket granting Virgin Mobile USA, L.P.'s petition for limited designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier and Motion for Waiver of the Lifeline Call Plan Rule.

2. Paragraph 16 of the Commission's November 2, 2011 Order stated that, "Based on the foregoing, the Commission grants conditional approval of Virgin Mobile's Motion for Waiver and orders Virgin Mobile to provide quarterly reports as discussed above."

3. Paragraph D of the Commission's November 2, 2011 Order stated that, "Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. shall provide the Commission with quarterly reports as discussed in Paragraph 16 of this Order."

4. The Commission finds its November 2, 2011 Order should be modified to amend the language of paragraph D from "Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. shall provide the Commission with quarterly reports as discussed in Paragraph 16 of this Order," to "Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. shall file quarterly reports as described above at Paragraph 16 in a new Compliance Docket. Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. will include a cover page on all such filings, captioned 'In the Matter of Virgin Mobile USA, L.P.'s Quarterly Report Compliance Filings as Required by Commission Order dated November 2, 2011, in Docket No. 10-VMBZ-657-ETC.' To the extent any such filing or portion thereof is confidential, Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. shall adhere to K.A.R. 82-1-221a."

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The language in paragraph D of the Commission's November 2, 2011 Order granting Virgin Mobile USA, L.P.'s petition for limited designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier and Motion for Waiver of the Lifeline call plan rule is hereby changed. The correct language of paragraph D is "Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. shall file quarterly reports as described above at Paragraph 16 in a new Compliance Docket. Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. will include a cover page on all such filings, captioned 'In the Matter of Virgin Mobile USA, L.P.'s Quarterly Report Compliance Filings as Required by Commission Order dated November 2, 2011, in Docket No. 10-VMBZ-657-ETC.' To the extent any such filing or portion thereof is confidential, Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. shall adhere to K.A.R. 82-1-221a."

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.

C. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).
