Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2), corporations must enter an appearance via an D. attorney. If a corporation fails to enter an appearance via an attorney prior to the Prehearing Conference, it may be held in default pursuant to the KAPA.

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for reconsideration.<sup>3</sup>
