### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

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Staff recommends approval of Westar Energy's revised 2013 Ad Valorem Tax Surcharge Rider. This surcharge would be in effect during the calendar year of 2013 and is in addition to the Ad Valorem tax that was included in base rates from Westar Energy's most recent rate case. The revised surcharge amount, discussed below, is \$21,812,232. This would result in an increase of residential customer bills by \$0.58 each month or \$6.96 annually based on average monthly usage levels of 750 kWh, \$0.70 each month or \$8.40 annually based on average monthly usage levels of 900 kWh, and \$0.96 each month or \$11.52 annually based on average monthly usage levels of 1250 kWh.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Westar Energy, Inc. (Westar North) and Kansas Gas and Electric Company (Westar South) both doing business as Westar Energy (Westar) filed an Ad Valorem tax surcharge request on November 29, 2012, with the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC or Commission). The Ad Valorem tax surcharge was filed in accordance with K.S.A. 66-117a(f) which provides for a utility to collect increases in its Ad Valorem taxes above amounts currently included in rates.

The statute also requires a Commission Order within 30 days of the filing date which, in this docket, is by December 29, 2012. Westar is requesting a consolidated surcharge of \$21,893,561 or \$0.001111 per kWh.

# ANALYSIS:

Staff performed an on-site review of Westar Energy, Inc.'s 2012 Ad Valorem tax statements. During Staff's review of Westar's Ad Valorem tax statements, Westar provided Staff an updated surcharge calculation to reflect additional property tax statements received since filing the Application. This change is reflected in the attachment to Staff's report. During Staff's on-site review, Staff was provided copies of the actual Ad Valorem tax statements including those that were estimated in the Application. With the exception of the aforementioned update, Westar's 2012 Ad Valorem tax statements matched those of its Application. Staff recommends that Westar be allowed to recover its Ad Valorem tax surcharge of \$21,812,232, or \$0.001106 per kWh. This surcharge reflects increases to Westar's Ad Valorem tax amounts that are currently being recovered through base rates and to reflect the over recovery of Ad Valorem taxes to its customers during 2012. Staff's recommendation will be recovered through Westar's Ad Valorem Tax Surcharge Tariff. Staff Exhibit 1 shows the 2012 property taxes as well as the amount allocated out for transmission (Westar has a Transmission Delivery Charge which collects this portion of the tax, along with other transmission related expenses).

When comparing the actual Ad Valorem tax invoices from 2012 to amounts collected for Ad Valorem tax during the calendar year, Westar prorated the amount of Ad Valorem tax collected through base rates from Dockets 08-WSEE-1041-RTS (1041 Docket) and 12-WSEE-112-RTS (112 Docket). Rates from the 112 Docket began to be collected at the end of April 2012. Therefore the amount of Ad Valorem tax included in the 112 Docket's base rates was only collected for 8 months in 2012, with 4 months of recovery from the 1041 Docket's base rates. Staff utilized actual kWh recorded in the months of January through November 2012, and December 2011 as an estimate for December 2012, totaled the amount of kWh recorded in January through April and May through December, then calculated the percentage of sales that should be related the 1041 and 112 Dockets. Staff has attached the calculation as Staff Exhibit 2.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve Westar's Ad Valorem tax surcharge amount of \$21,812,232 with the following conditions:

- 1. Westar shall file updated tariffs with the Commission reflecting the revised surcharge before implementing the surcharge.
- 2. Staff shall review the updated surcharge to ensure the surcharge is applied in a reasonable manner and is calculated to substantially collect the increase in Ad Valorem taxes.
- 3. Staff will ensure that the annual true-up of amounts collected vs. actual amount of increase or reduction in Ad Valorem taxes will be reflected in the subsequent year Ad Valorem tax surcharge calculation.
- 4. Staff requests that Westar file its Ad Valorem Tax Surcharge Rider annual true-up in December of each calendar year.
