ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On January 17, 2017, Commission Staff (Staff) issued a Notice of Denial of License Renewal Application to Noble Petroleum, Inc. (Operator), stating that individuals associated with Operator are associated with entities not in compliance with Commission statutes, regulations and orders.
 - 2. On January 19, 2017, Operator filed its request for a hearing in this matter.
- 3. On February 9, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a Prehearing Conference in this matter.¹
- 4. On March 3, 2017, Staff filed a Motion to Close [the] Docket, stating that any problems with granting Operator a license have been resolved to Staff's satisfaction, and Staff no longer wishes to contest Operator's license application.² Staff noted it has processed Operator's application, and Operator is now licensed.³ Thus, Staff requested that the docket be closed.⁴

The Commission is satisfied with Staff's administrative processing and granting of Operator's license. Thus, the Commission finds the matter is appropriately resolved, and this docket should be closed.

- A. This docket is closed.
- B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition for reconsideration.⁵
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
