You and each of you are hereby notified that Unit Petroleum Company ("Unit Petroleum") has filed an Application pursuant to K.S.A. § 55-1301, et seq., requesting an Order providing for the unitization and unit operation of the Langdon Waterflood Unit in Reno County, Kansas. Unit Petroleum proposes to unitize the Mississippi Lime formation encountered in the subsurface between the depths of 3,846' and 3,936' as shown in the electrical surveys of the Maxwell "A" #2 well located in the center of the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 16-T25S-R9W for the purposes of implementing enhanced oil recovery operations in said formation in order to increase the recovery of hydrocarbon reserves. The unit area of the proposed Langdon Waterflood Unit, which Unit Petroleum will operate, is comprised of the following lands:

Township 25 South, Range 9 West,
Reno County, KS
Section 15: W/2
Section 16: All
Section 17: E/2
Section 20: N/2
Section 21: N/2, SE/4
Section 22: W/2

The Application is pending with the Commission. Any persons who object to such Application shall be required to file their protest in writing with the Kansas Corporation Commission ("KCC") within 15 days from the date of this publication. If a written protest is not timely filed with the KCC, the Application may be determined administratively by the KCC and may thereby be granted without hearing or further notice to any interested party. Any interested person wishing to object to or protest this Application shall do so, in writing, shall clearly state the reasons why granting the Application will violate correlative rights, cause waste or threaten fresh and usable waters. Protests shall be mailed to the Kansas Corporation Commission, Conservation Division, 265 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas, 67202, with a copy to counsel for Unit Petroleum listed below.

All parties in any way interested or concerned shall take notice of the foregoing and govern themselves accordingly.
