## **BACKGROUND:**

On January 24, 2008, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Kansas (AT&T), filed an Application for approval of a Modification to an Interconnection Agreement between themselves and XO Communications Services, Inc (XO), previously approved by this Commission on October 24, 2005.

Approval is being sought under Section 252(e) of the Federal Act.

AT&T and XO are certificated Local Exchange Carriers in the State of Kansas. At the time of this filing, both are properly registered with the Kansas Secreary of State's office and are 'active and in good standing' with the Secretary's office. Both are current with their KUSF assessments and KCC fees.

Commission action in this matter is required not later than April 23, 2008.

## **ANALYSIS:**

This Modification seeks to extend the Agreement's expiration date from December 11, 2008, to December 11, 2011.

The parties state that this Amendment, with the original Agreement, are an integrated package, the result of negotiation and compromise andthat there are no outstanding issues between themselves needing the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

Section 252(e) of the Federal Act statesthat state commissions may reject a negotiated agreement only if it finds that the agreement (or portions thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or the implementation of such an agreement (or portions thereof)s not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Staff has reviewed this proposed Modification and finds no such cause for concern with this filing.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends commission approval.
