2. On March 1, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for the Designation of a Prehearing Officer and the Scheduling of a Prehearing Conference Regarding Cancellation of the Commission's March 14, 1994 and September 22, 1994 Orders (Motion).
