**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) on Evergy Kansas Central, Inc.’s (“Evergy”) Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice. Having examined its pleadings and records, the Commission concludes the following:

1. On August 29, 2024, Teddy Banks and Kristy Little (“Complainants”) filed a Formal Complaint against Evergy<sup>1</sup>, and on September 17, 2024, the Commission issued its Order Making *Prima Facie* Determination, wherein the Commission found Complainants had proffered a sufficient complaint that Evergy provided an unreasonably high quote to provide electricity to their residence.<sup>2</sup>

2. On September 27, 2024, Evergy filed a Motion for Leave to File Out of Time requesting leave to file its Answer out of time no later than Friday, October 4, 2024, in order for Evergy to attempt to settle the Complaint.<sup>3</sup> Subsequently, the Commission granted Evergy’s Motion for Leave to File Out of Time.<sup>4</sup>

3. On October 3, 2024, Evergy filed a Motion to Dismiss Without Prejudice, stating that on October 2, 2024, Evergy and the Complainants had reached an agreement; that the matter

had been resolved; and that Everyg was authorized to state that the Complainants support the resolution and Everyg's Motion.<sup>5</sup>

4. Given the parties' resolution to this matter, the Commission finds this matter should be closed and Everyg's Motion to Dismiss should be granted.

**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

A. Everyg's Motion to Dismiss Without Prejudice is granted. This matter is closed without prejudice.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).<sup>6</sup>
