APPLICATION TO CEASE

COMES NOW Evergy Kansas Central Inc. d/b/a Evergy Kansas Central (“Evergy Kansas Central”), and in support of its Application to Cease states:

1. Evergy Kansas Central is a Kansas corporation authorized by the Commission to conduct the business of a public utility under the provisions of K.S.A. 66-104, and as such holds a Certificate of Convenience and Authority from this Commission to engage in the business of an electric public utility in the State of Kansas, thereby promoting the public convenience in the following described territory:

BUTLER COUNTY, KANSAS

The tract of land begins 542.5S NE/C NE4 S100 W435 N100 E435 TO POB LESS ROW in Section 30, Township 28 South, Range 03 East in Butler County, Kansas. See Map Exhibit A.

2. Butler Rural Electric Cooperative Association, Inc. (“Butler Rural”) certified territory is adjacent to the territory described in paragraph 1.

3. Evergy currently serves a storage shed owned by the customer on the parcel of land that is in Evergy service territory and Butler Rural serves the customer’s home that is in Butler Rural’s service territory. The customer is requesting to have only one service provider. Butler Rural lines and equipment are already installed on the East side of the road right by the shed that

Evergy is currently serving. For Evergy to serve the house, Evergy would need to extend their lines North a few spans and then over to the house.

4. Evergy Kansas Central and Butler Rural have mutually agreed, subject to the Commission's approval, that Butler Rural should serve as an electric public utility in the territory described in paragraph 1.



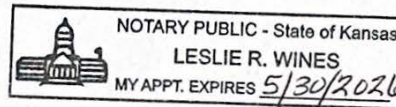
