ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On December 6, 2018, Merit Energy Company, LLC (“Operator”) submitted an application seeking an exception to the 10-year time limitations of K.A.R. 82-3-111.¹ On January 31, 2019, the Operator filed an Amended Application.
2. On May 10, 2019, the Operator filed a Motion to Withdraw Application without Prejudice. The Motion stated that since the filing of the application the Operator determined it needed to plug the well.² District Staff confirmed that the well was plugged on May 8, 2019.
3. In light of the Applicant’s withdrawal of the Application, the Commission finds further proceedings are unnecessary, this docket should be closed.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. This docket is closed.


B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).³
