ORDER APPROVING STAFF'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). For consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, the Commission finds and concludes:

1. On January 21, 2025, Sunflower Electric Power Corporation (Sunflower") and Lane-Scott Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Lane-Scott") filed a Joint Application with the Commission requesting approval of the City of Dighton Firm Energy, Capacity, and Load Following Agreement ("Dighton Agreement") between Sunflower, Lane and the City of Dighton.¹

2. Sunflower and Lane-Scott have elected to be exempt from Commission jurisdiction, regulation, supervision and control pursuant to K.S.A. 66-104d(f), the sale of power for resale to non-member-owners remains subject to Commission regulation. The Dighton Agreement is a contract for the sale of power for resale between Sunflower, Lane-Scott and the City of Dighton (a non-member-owner), and therefore the subject matter of the agreement is subject to Commission jurisdiction. The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over the matter.

3. On May 21, 2025, Commission Staff filed confidential and redacted versions of its Report and Recommendation ("Report"), which recommended approval of the Dighton Agreement.²

4. The Commission adopts Staffs' Report and Recommendations as findings.

5. The Commission finds the Dighton Agreement will ultimately benefit all the parties involved.

6. After review of Staff's Report, the application and the Dighton Agreement, the Commission concludes the Dighton Agreement is just and reasonable.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The Commission hereby adopts Staff's Report and Recommendation filed May 21, 2025.

B. The Dighton Agreement is approved.

C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529 (a)(1).³

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
