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
<sup>1</sup> At the prehearing conference, the prehearing officer indicated a preference that parties present only one witnesses each. However, Westar and CURB request approval from the Commission to present all of their witnesses that filed affidavits at the evidentiary hearing. Each of CURB's two witnesses and Westar's three witnesses cover substantially different topics and it would be very difficult for one of them to adopt the others' affidavits and support them on cross-examination at the hearing.

<sup>2</sup> IBEW, United Wind, and Brightergy filed comments in the docket but did not provided a signed affidavit by a supporting witness; instead, their pleadings were signed by their attorneys. The prehearing officer directed these parties to provide signed affidavits by June 16, 2017, if they intend to present a witness at the hearing.



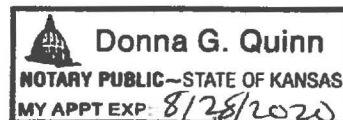
