ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION


On September 22, 2003, BOC Gases filed a petition to intervene in this proceeding. The petition states that BOC Gases is an electric customer of Aquila, Inc., that it has an interest in the prices charged under the energy cost adjustment mechanism of Aquila, and that Aquila does not object to its intervention. No responses to the petition to intervene have been filed. The Commission finds that intervention is appropriate under K.A.R. 82-1-225(a) and grants the petition.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

The petition to intervene of BOC Gases is granted. A party may file for reconsideration of this Order within 15 days of the date of this Order. If service is by mail, 3 additional days may be added to the 15-day time limit. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
