In reply to the KCC acknowledgement of receipt of my 20 February letter of protest against the application filed by Marshall Oil LLC to commence the disposal of saltwater into the Douglas formation at the **Teter-Spencer Lease and well No. 2A** 4950 FSL 4290 FEL; located in the NW/4 of the Sec.22 Twp.23S R 9E, Greenwood County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 1000 psig, and a maximum injection rate of 1500 bbls per day, and for the reasons stated in my previous letter of protest, I am now writing to request a public hearing on the matter of that particular application.

For the reasons I have stated in my previous letter of protest which speak specifically to concerns of violations of correlative rights and damages and pollution to this natural resource area of Kansas, I believe that the Kansas Corporation Commission should hold a public hearing on the application filed Marshall Oil LLC to commence the disposal of saltwater into the Douglas formation **Teter-Spencer Lease and well No. 2A** 4950 FSL 4290 FEL; located in the NW/4 of the Sec.22 Twp.23S R 9E, Greenwood County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 1000 psig, and a maximum injection rate of 1500 bbls per day.
