## RESPONSE TO OPERATOR'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS

Comes now Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively) in response to the Meridian Energy Motion for Summary Proceedings filed on behalf of Neal Lafon Realty Inc. dba Meridian Energy Inc. (Operator) on June 14, 2022. In support, Staff states the following:

- 1. On May 9, 2022, Operator filed their application requesting an order authorizing the unitization and unit operation of the Simon Says Unit in Rawlins County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 55-1301, et seq.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. Notice was properly served and met the requirements of K.S.A. 55-1310, K.S.A. 55-605, and K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protests or objections have been submitted to the Commission in this matter.
- 3. May 24, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference scheduling the prehearing conference.<sup>2</sup>
- 4. On June 14, 2022, Operator filed a motion for summary proceedings (Motion) in lieu of an evidentiary hearing as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA).<sup>3</sup>

5. Staff has reviewed Operator's Application in this matter. Staff is satisfied that the

grant of such Application complies with the applicable statutory and regulatory requirements. As

such, Staff has no objection to the Motion because it appears the KAPA notice and hearing

requirements mandated by K.S.A. 55-1303 and K.S.A. 55-1304 are met, and Operator's

application qualifies for summary proceedings under K.S.A. 77-537.

In conclusion, for the reasons described above, Staff recommends approval of the

Operator's Application for the Unitization of the Simon Says Unit as the Application will prevent

waste, protect correlative rights, and that there does not appear to be any current pollution threat.
