MOTION TO REINSTATE INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission reinstate the Kansas motor carrier operations of Bryce Heckert, d/b/a B. Heckert Trucking of Girard, Kansas (Respondent). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Respondent is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5, as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
- 2. Respondent is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 2288110.
- 3. On March 6, 2018, the Commission issued an Order suspending Respondent's intrastate motor carrier operations other than such motor carrier operations excepted from the Commission's regulation under K.S.A. 66-1,129, due to non-compliance with a Penalty Order issued in this docket on January 4, 2018. The Penalty Order also assessed Respondent a \$2,000 civil fine.
- 4. On April 17, 2020, Respondent submitted evidence to Staff of bringing its motor carrier operation into compliance with Kansas motor carrier safety statutes, rules and regulations

pursuant to the above-referenced Penalty Order. Respondent also paid the \$2000 penalty assessment.

- 5. Therefore, Staff asks the Commission to find that Respondent has now complied with the requirements of the above-referenced Penalty Order.
- 6. Staff also asks the Commission to reinstate Respondent's Kansas motor carrier operations.
- 7. Furthermore, Staff asks the Commission to order Respondent to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days, pursuant to paragraph (B) of the Penalty Order, and to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order reinstating Respondent's Kansas motor carrier operations and ordering Respondent to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days, pursuant to paragraph (B) of the Penalty Order and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.
