# STAFF'S MOTION TO REOPEN DOCKET AND CHANGE DOCKET NUMBER FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES

The Staff of the Kansas Corporation Commission (Staff and Commission, respectively), hereby moves the Commission to reopen the immediate docket and change the assigned docket number for administrative purposes. In support thereof, Staff states the following:

- 1. On September 14, 2015, Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink; United Telephone Company of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; United Telephone Company of Southcentral Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; and United Telephone Company of Eastern Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink (collectively, CenturyLink) filed an *Application for Approval of an Interconnection Agreement* (Application) between itself and QuantumShift Communications, Inc. (QuantumShift). The Application was approved on December 1, 2015.
- 2. The Commission assigned docket number to the proceeding was Docket No. 16-USET-143-IAT.
- 3. CenturyLink's usual company code for docketing purposes is "UTDT" rather than "USET." "USET" is typically used to refer only to Embarq Missouri rather than the United Telephone Companies of Kansas as a collective. For purposes of consistency and ease of finding

information on CenturyLink, Staff requests that the docket number assigned to this case be changed to Docket No. 16-UTDT-143-IAT.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission change the docket number assigned to this proceeding to Docket No. 16-UTDT-143-IAT.
