This letter is to inform you that your challenge concerning violations 383.23A2 – Operating a CMV without a CDL and 396.3A1 – Inspection/repair and maintenance parts & accessories has been denied. The violations will remain on your carrier profile. When inspected, the 383.23A2 violation was listed for operating a 2013 Ford Truck with a GVWR of 33000 pounds without the proper class of license. The driver needed a Class B CDL with tank endorsement at the time of stop. A GVWR greater than 26000 pounds requires a CDL. Please reference Part 390.5 'definitions' for the explanation of CMV The 396.3A1 violation was specifically recorded as 396.3A1LLEAK. When inspected, it was discovered that diesel fuel was dripping from the passenger side saddle tank at the drain plug. A liquid fuel system with a dripping leak at any point is an OOS violation.

Invoices # H000576294, H000576335 remain valid and provide information for payment of the fines due. If you are dissatisfied with this outcome, please be advised that you have the right to an administrative hearing with the Kansas Corporation Commission.

Your request for hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Hearing requests shall be sent to the Kansas Highway Patrol at the address listed above and <u>must</u> be received within fifteen days from the date of this letter.
