ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER & SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

- 1. On May 16, 2016, Agricultural Energy Services filed an application requesting an exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for its Diamond Sleeper 1-25 well. On June 14, 2016, Warren F. Fox filed a protest.

Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202. Telephonic attendance may be permitted upon advance request to the Prehearing Officer. The Prehearing Conference will focus on the development of a procedural schedule.

- C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, scheduling of a hearing with the Commission, and any other issues that will promote the orderly and prompt resolution of this proceeding.
- D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act ("KAPA"). Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding shall be held in default under the KAPA.
- E. <u>Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2), corporations must enter an appearance via an attorney. If a corporation fails to enter an appearance via an attorney prior to the Prehearing Conference, it shall be held in default under the KAPA.</u>
