This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On April 10, 2018, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Rick Housel

dba Rick's Well Service (Operator) for failure to comply with K.A.R. 82-3-107 and K.A.R. 82-3-

130 due to Operator's failure to submit a complete, accurate well completion report, with the associated documents, within 120 days of the spud date.¹

2. On May 2, 2018, Operator filed a letter requesting a hearing.

3. On May 24, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was scheduled for July 12, 2018.²

4. On July 12, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was held, wherein Conservation Staff

(Staff) and the Operator agreed to a continuance until August 9, 2018, so that Staff and the Operator might have an opportunity to resolve this matter.

5. Based on the above, the Prehearing Officer finds the Prehearing Conference shall be continued until August 9, 2018, at 10:30 a.m.
