**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER AMENDING THE TIME OF PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On July 13, 2018, Palomino Petroleum, Inc. (Applicant) filed an Application to authorize injection of saltwater into the Arbuckle formation at the Carter Trust SWD #1 well in Ness County, Kansas.<sup>1</sup>
2. On August 17, 2018, Cindy Hoedel filed a letter of protest and request for hearing.<sup>2</sup>
3. On October 23, 2018, the Commission issued an *Order on Protestant's Motion for Default and Dismissal of Applicant*, scheduling a Prehearing Conference for November 8, 2018, at 9:00 a.m.<sup>3</sup>

4. Subsequent to the Commission's October 23, 2018 Order, the parties agreed via email to change the November 8, 2018 Prehearing Conference meeting time from 9:00 a.m., Central Time, to 11:30 a.m., Central Time.

A. The November 8, 2018, Prehearing Conference will convene at 11:30 a.m., Central Time.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).<sup>4</sup>

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
