## **NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On February 27, 2018, the Commission issued the Proposed Default Order finding the Operator in default for failure to attend the Prehearing Conference.
- 2. Ordering Clause C of the Proposed Default Order inadvertently stated the incorrect relief under a Proposed Default Order pursuant to K.S.A. 77-520. The language should have stated:
  - C. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-520(b), any party may file a written motion requesting that this Default Order be vacated and stating the grounds relied upon, within seven calendar days after service of this Order, with three additional days added to account for service by mail. If no request to vacate is received the Penalty Order shall become effective.

3. Because the Defaulted Party's rights are statutory, the Commission finds that the mistake does not affect the Operator's obligations under a Proposed Default. No other provisions of the February 28, 2018 Proposed Default Order are altered or amended in any way.

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Ordering Clause C of the Commission's Proposed Default Order is hereby stricken and replaced by the language expressed in paragraph 2 above.
- B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
