The purpose of this

hearing is to allow those

note that K.A.R. 82-1-

through an attorney. Pur-  
suant to K.A.R. 82-1-229,  
Intervenors and Protes-  
tants, if any, must prefile  
direct testimony ten (10)  
days prior to the date of  
the hearing. Rebuttal testi-  
mony may be presented at  
the hearing. If you fail to  
appear at this hearing or  
prefile testimony, the Com-  
mission may proceed to  
hear evidence against you  
and enter such order as  
shall be justified by the evi-  
dence.

Any person requiring  
special accommodations  
under The Americans With  
Disabilities Act needs to  
give notice to the Commis-  
sion at least ten (10) days  
prior to the scheduled hear-  
ing date.

The Commission will  
preside over this hearing.
