MOTION FOR ORDER CORRECTING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE

COME NOW the identified rural telephone companies¹ ("RLECs") and move the Commission to issue an Order Correcting the Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC")

Certificate of Convenience previously granted to Suddenlink in Docket No. 13-CKST-711-COC.

In support, the RLECs show the Commission as follows:

On May 17, 2013, in Docket No. 13-CKST-711-COC, Cebridge Telecom KS, LLC d/b/a Suddenlink ("Suddenlink"), filed an application requesting the Commission grant it local exchange and exchange access operating authority in "all areas in Kansas." The Commission's order, dated August 29, 2013, granted Suddenlink authority to operate "within the State of Kansas."
- 2. As explained further in the Petition to Intervene, Objection to Interconnection Agreement and Petition to Appropriately Limit CLEC Certificate of Convenience filed simultaneously in Docket No. 13-CKST-711-COC and in Docket No. 24-CKST-248-IAT, on September 15, 2023, Kansas law does not give Suddenlink the ability to provide service outside of AT&T and CenturyLink legacy service areas.
- 3. As noted by the Commission in its Order Granting Petition to Intervene, filed in both dockets on November 21, 2023, there has been no response to the Petition to Intervene. Although Suddenlink, on December 4, 2023, filed a Motion to Withdraw its application for approval of an interconnection agreement, which the RLECs do not oppose, that Motion did not address the RLECs' pending Petition to Appropriately Limit CLEC Certificate of Convenience. MoKan and SuddenLink have not raised any objections or provided any arguments against correcting the certificate of convenience. Failing to raise any objections should be considered a default of this issue.

WHEREFORE, there being no objections or reasons otherwise, the Commission should grant the RLECs request, and issue an order correcting SuddenLink's certificate of convenience to conform to Kansas law and appropriately limit SuddenLink's operating authority in Kansas to AT&T and CenturyLink legacy service areas.
