PETITION TO INTERVENE AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED PROTECTIVE ORDER

Supp. 66-2005(q)(1).

COMES NOW, the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB") and moves the Corporation Commission of the State of the Kansas ("Commission") for an Order permitting it to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding and for an expedited protective order. In support of its petition and motion, CURB states and alleges as follows:

- 1. CURB is composed of five volunteer consumer advocate members and is statutorily authorized to represent the interests of Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers in utility proceedings.
- 2. CURB's Consumer Counsel has been given the discretion to intervene and represent the interests of Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers in any utility proceeding before the Commission under K.S.A. 66-1223 et seq.

- 3. On November 21, 2008, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") d/b/a AT&T Kansas, filed an application for price deregulation of residential telecommunications services in the Humboldt, Kansas exchange and business telecommunication services in the Seneca, Great Bend, Iola, Lyons, Pittsburg and Winfield, Kansas exchanges pursuant to K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 66-2005(q)(1)(C) and (D).
- 4. CURB is requesting permission to intervene in this docket to represent the interests of the residential and small commercial ratepayers of Kansas. The rates paid and the service received by those customers will or may be affected by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding.
- 5. The representation of CURB's interests in this proceeding by existing parties is or may be inadequate.
- 6. The residential and small commercial ratepayers whose interests CURB represents will or may be bound by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding and will or may be adversely affected thereby.
- 7. In the filing, certain attachments contain carrier specific data that SWBT considers to be proprietary and confidential information; therefore, CURB is requesting the Commission issue a protective order to allow CURB and its consultant access to the full information contained in this filing.
- 8. Because the Commission is required to act upon the petition within 21 days (plus one 30-day extension order) under K.S.A. 66-2005(q)(1), CURB respectfully requests that the Commission issue an expedited protective order in this docket.

WHEREFORE, CURB RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS THE Commission grant its petition for intervention and request for an expedited protective order in this docket.
