ORDER GRANTING SOUTHERN STAR'S PETITION TO INTERVENE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On March 29, 2024, Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills") filed an Application requesting approval of the transfer of certain assets, customers, and accounts related to farm taps from Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline, Inc. ("Southern Star") to Black Hills under an Asset Purchase Agreement ("APA") executed between Black Hills and Southern Star and further requesting the Commission issue customer-specific certificates of convenience and necessity for Black Hills to serve the farm tap customers.¹

2. On May 17, 2024, Southern Star petitioned for intervention in this matter.²

Southern Star stated its intervention in the matter was in the interest of justice and would not

impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings.³ Southern Star identified itself as the

counter-party to the APA, which is the basis of Black Hills' pending Application.⁴ As such,

Southern Star contended its rights may be substantially affected by any Commission order or

activity in this proceeding.⁵ No other party is currently authorized to represent Southern Star in

this proceeding.6

3. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in

the interest of justice, if the intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the

proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties, and privileges,

immunities, or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.⁷

4. The Commission finds Southern Star has demonstrated an interest in this

proceeding. Therefore, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-521, the Commission grants Southern Star's

Petition for Intervention.
