On March 20, 2018, Urban Oil and Gas Group LLC (Operator) filed an Application 1.

seeking authorization for injection of saltwater into the Arbuckle formation at the Lygrisse #82X well in Sedgwick County, Kansas.¹

2. On April 6, 2018, Benjamin M. Giles (Protestant) filed a letter of protest, and on

May 7, 2018, requested a hearing.²

3. On May 24, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was scheduled for July 12, 2018.³
