**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CONTINUING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On March 20, 2018, Urban Oil and Gas Group LLC (Operator) filed an Application seeking authorization for injection of saltwater into the Arbuckle formation at the Lygrisse #82X well in Sedgwick County, Kansas.<sup>1</sup>
2. On April 6, 2018, Benjamin M. Giles (Protestant) filed a letter of protest, and on May 7, 2018, requested a hearing.<sup>2</sup>
3. On May 24, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was scheduled for July 12, 2018.<sup>3</sup>
4. On July 12, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was held. Counsel for the Operator appeared, but Staff and the Protestant did not appear. Counsel for the Operator stated he had no objection to continuing the Prehearing Conference.

5. Based on the above, the Prehearing Officer finds the Prehearing Conference shall be continued until August 9, 2018, at 11:00 a.m.

B. Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.<sup>4</sup>

C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).<sup>5</sup>

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
