RE: RJM Company Application for a permit to authorize the enhanced recovery of saltwater into the Doll Lease Well No. 3 located in Barton County, Kansas.
TO: All Oil and Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomsoever concerned.
You, and each of you, are hereby notified that RJM Company has filed an application to commence the injection of saltwater into the Lansing Kansas City formation at the Doll Lease Well No. 3 330 FSL 1860 FVL located in the SW/4 of the Sec. 27 Twp. 18S. R. 11W, Barton County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 1500 psig and a maximum injection rate of 7500 bbls per day.
Any persons who object to or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protest with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within thirty days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why the grant of the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the State of Kansas.
All persons interested or concerned shall take notice of the foregoing and shall govern themselves accordingly.
