**MOTION FOR ORDER AMENDING PENALTY ASSESSMENT**

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), by and through its counsel, Ahsan A. Latif, files this Motion requesting the Commission issue an Order Amending Penalty Assessment reducing the penalty assessed to A-1 Towing and Recovery Co (A-1 Towing and Recovery), fifty-percent (50%) less than the penalty assessed in the Penalty Order dated November 14, 2019. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. On November 14, 2019, a Penalty Order was issued to A-1 Towing and Recovery assessing it a penalty of \$1,400 for three (3) violation(s) of Kansas law that governs motor carriers, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations. The violations were found during a Safety Compliance Review conducted on October 23, 2019, by Special Investigator Michael Heenan.

2. The Notice of Penalty Assessment advised A-1 Towing and Recovery it was a New Entrant carrier and may be eligible for a fifty-percent (50%) reduced penalty if it submitted a signed and dated Reduced Penalty Agreement within fifteen (15) days from the date of the Penalty Order, stating it will comply with the reduced penalty option terms and obligations stated therein.

3. On December 9, 2019, A-1 Towing and Recovery submitted the Reduced Penalty Agreement. The Corrective Action Plan was submitted by the carrier and has been approved by Transportation Staff. The Reduced Penalty Agreement is attached hereto and is hereby incorporated by reference.

4. Staff recommends the Commission issue an Order Amending Penalty Assessment assessing A-1 Towing and Recovery a 50% reduced penalty of \$700 and requesting it to comply with the following terms and obligations:

- a. within thirty (30) days from the date of the Penalty Order dated November 14, 2019, A-1 Towing and Recovery shall send an individual responsible for safety compliance to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar, and proof of attendance must be submitted to Litigation Counsel;
- b. within eighteen (18) months of the Penalty Order, A-1 Towing and Recovery must submit to a follow-up Safety Compliance Review. Transportation Staff will contact the carrier to set up the review; and
- c. within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Order Amending Penalty Assessment, A-1 Towing and Recovery must make the payment of \$700 through the KTRAN system located at <https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/>.

**WHEREFORE**, for the reasons set forth herein, Staff requests an Order Amending Penalty Assessment be issued by the Commission assessing A-1 Towing and Recovery Co a reduced penalty of \$700 and ordering it to comply with the proposed terms and obligations set out in paragraph 4 above.



### REDUCED PENALTY AGREEMENT

#### 20-TRAM-206-PEN


A-1 Towing and Recovery Co (A-1 Towing and Recovery) hereby submits this Reduced Penalty Agreement for approval of a fifty percent (50%) reduction in the penalty assessed in the Penalty Order dated November 14, 2019. A-1 Towing and Recovery has agreed to comply with the following terms and obligations:

1. A-1 Towing and Recovery has submitted, within fifteen (15) days from the date of the Penalty Order this signed and dated Reduced Penalty Agreement to Litigation Counsel.
2. A-1 Towing and Recovery will, within thirty (30) days from the date of the Penalty Order, submit to Transportation Staff a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) documenting the violation(s) and describing specific and detailed information explaining its efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future. I understand the CAP must be approved by Transportation Staff to become eligible for the 50% reduced penalty.
3. A-1 Towing and Recovery will, within thirty (30) days from the date of the Penalty Order, send an individual responsible for safety compliance to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar, and proof of attendance will be submitted to the Litigation Counsel.
4. A-1 Towing and Recovery will be available within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order for a follow-up Safety Compliance Review. Transportation Staff will contact the carrier to schedule the review.

A-1 Towing and Recovery Co understands that if approved, an Order Amending Penalty Assessment will be issued by the Commission assessing a reduced penalty of \$700, and will set out the terms and conditions stated above. Once the Order Amending Penalty Assessment is issued by the Commission, A-1 Towing and Recovery will have thirty (30) days from the date of service of that Order to pay the reduced penalty assessed.
