PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER RESCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

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This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On October 19, 2017, the Commission issued its Order to Show Cause, Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference (Order), scheduling a Prehearing Conference for November 14, 2017.¹

2. At the November 14, 2017, Prehearing Conference, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) verbally moved to have the Prehearing Conference continued for 60 days.

3. On November 16, 2017, Staff confirmed its verbal motion by filing a Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference, asking that the Prehearing Conference be rescheduled for the third week of January 2018 to allow time for further discussion between Staff and the Operator regarding how best to resolve this docket and to determine whether the outcome should be affected by the bankruptcy proceeding in this matter.

4. The Prehearing Officer finds Staff's continuance request to be reasonable in light of the above circumstances.

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
