<u>APPLICATION TO AMEND CERTIFICATE</u>

Plains Producers Association, Inc., (Plains Producers), hereby makes this Application to the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission), pursuant to K.S.A. § 66-104c, requesting expedited approval by October 1, 2014, of an amendment to Plains Producers' service territory to include Alexander Feeders, located at 2071 US HWY 54, Plains, Kansas. In support of its Application, Plains Producers states the following:

- 1. Plains Producers is a customer-owned Kansas not-for-profit corporation, in good standing, operating as a certificated nonprofit natural gas public utility in portions of Seward and Meade County, Kansas. On May 21, 1999, and pursuant to K.S.A. § 66-104c and K.S.A. § 66-131, the Commission granted Plains Producers' a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Kansas nonprofit public utility in Docket No. 99-PPAG-669-COC.
- 2. Plains Producers continues to qualify as a nonprofit public utility under the provisions of K.S.A. § 66-104c(a). Specifically, Plains Producers states that (1) [e]very customer, shareholder, household or meter owner is an owner of the Plains Producers and has an equal vote on matters concerning the utility; (2) Plains Producers employs no full-time employees; and (3) Plains Producers has no more than 100 customers. A list of the Plains Producers' member-shareholders is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

- 3. Alexander Feeders, is located at 2071 US HWY 54, Plains, Kansas, and is a pig farm operation located in the service territory of Black Hills Energy (Black Hills). Alexander Feeders is currently using propane to fuel its operation and has been in discussions with Black Hills regarding the possibility of Plains Producers extending natural gas service to the facility. Black Hills has indicated that it is agreeable to allowing Plains Producers to serve Alexander Feeders at the Plains, Kansas location. As a result, Plains Producers and Black Hills agreed that Plains Producers will seek Commission approval to provide natural gas service to Alexander Feeders, and in exchange, Black Hills will not to object to Plains Producers' Application to Amend Certificate to include service to this customer specific location.
- 4. Plains Producers is seeking expedited approval of this Application because Alexander Feeders is faced with the necessity of procuring propane for the winter, which will result in significant expenditures for Alexander Feeders. Alexander Feeders hopes to offset the costs associated with the extension of the natural gas lines to its facility by avoiding the costs associated with filling its propane tanks.
- 5. Plains Producers requests that its certificate be amended to include natural gas service to one customer specific location only, identified as follows:

MEADE COUNTY

Alexander Feeders, located at 2071 US HWY 54, in the city of Plains, Kansas – NW1/4, S30, T32S, R30W, Meade County.

6. Plains Producers acknowledges that for the purposes of constructing the new natural gas supply line it has and will comply with all applicable pipeline safety laws as required by K.S.A. § 66-104c(b).

- 7. With winter approaching, time is of the essence in this matter. As such, Plains Producers respectfully requests the Commission issue its order in this matter by October 1, 2014.


