Dear Andrew Brensing,

I live in Burlington, KS and I have written to KCC to protest and to request a hearing in the matter of Permit Number E-27315, the Application for an Injection Well and the Application to Amend Injection Permit by your company, Cross Bar Energy, for the Vigle VW-6 and VW-8 wells in SW/4 of Section 14, Township 23-South, Range 10 East, Greenwood County.

Injecting toxic wastewater into the Bartlesville formation is dangerous, may pollute the natural resources of the state of Kansas including some of the most pristine water in the state – water which provides for all life living in the vicinity surrounding the proposed well sites and towns such as Eureka.

In addition, the US Geological Survey states that injection wells are the cause of the recent and ongoing earthquakes in Kansas. Those earthquakes continue to cause uncompensated damages to private and municipal property, and they are moving northward in the state, with several this month epi-centered near the Nebraska border.

For those reasons, I have asked KCC to err on the side of caution and deny your permit for injection authority.
