The effective date on each sheet has been excluded to allow for proper review and approval by KCC Staff.

The purpose of this filing is to make the following tariff changes:

- Residential access line rate will increase by \$1.50 for exchanges in Leoti, Tribune, Marienthal, Jetmore, Sharon Springs, Wallace & Weskan (Current access line rate is \$16.27 increasing to \$17.77)
- Residential access line rate will increase by \$1.50 for exchanges in Cedar Point, Saffordville & Americus (Current access line rate is \$19.74 increasing to \$21.24)
- Voice Advantage and Voice Advantage II bundles will increase by \$2.50 (residential access line rate increase of \$1.50 and intrastate long distance minutes rate increase of \$1.00)
- Home Phone bundles will increase by \$2.50 (residential access line rate increase of \$1.50 and interstate long distance minutes of \$1.00)

A copy of the bill messaging that will be used to notify customers of these changes is enclosed for your reference. These bill messages will be delivered to customers as part of the April 1, 2022, billing cycle.

3.11 Kansas Universal Service Fund

Beginning March 1, 1997, the Company will assess a fee for funding of the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF), including Kansas Lifeline Service Program (KLSP), and the Kansas Telecommunications Access Program (TAP). These funds were enacted by the Kansas Legislature in 1996, and authorized by the Kansas Corporation Commission on December 27, 1996 in Docket No. 190,492-U. The Amount of the fee may vary as determined by the Fund Administrator.

Use of the Voice Advantage II Bundle is prohibited for any profit or nonprofit commercial or governmental activities, including, but not limited to, activities related to home office, business, sales, telecommuting, telemarketing, continuous autodialing, fax broadcast, fax blasting, resale or transfer of the Voice Advantage II Bundle or any other activity that would be inconsistent with the normal residential voice-grade applications and usage patterns. If it is determined that the usage on the Voice Advantage II Bundle is not consistent with residential applications or is otherwise prohibited as specified in this tariff, Consolidated Communications of Kansas Company will contact the customer and arrange a transfer to a business service or terminate service under the residential Voice Advantage II Bundle. Additional restrictions may apply as provided elsewhere in the tariff.
