SUSPENSION ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On May 28, 2015, Jayhawk Pipeline, LLC, filed a request for Commission approval of tariff revisions that would increase certain tariff rates based on the annual FERC Index for 2015.

2. A full investigation of the request, which may result in a hearing, is deemed necessary and proper. Absent suspension of the effectiveness of the proposed revisions, Commission Staff is without sufficient time to fully review, consider, and analyze the request.

3. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of the effectiveness of the proposed tariff revisions and deferral of the effective date is required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. Therefore, the effectiveness of the proposed tariff revisions shall be suspended for a period of 240 days from the date the request was filed, May 28, 2015, until

Monday, January 25, 2016,¹ pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c). A final order may be issued before such date.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c), effectiveness of the proposed tariff revisions in the above-captioned docket shall be suspended, and the effective date deferred, until January 25, 2016.


B. Parties have 15 days, plus three days if service is by mail, from the date of service of this Order in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration.²

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary and proper.
