ACCESS SERVICES

I. INTRASTATE SWITCHED ACCESS SERVICES

The Company concurs in the intrastate Switch Access Service Tariffs of Blue Valley Tele-Communications, Inc. particularly in the rates, rules and regulations governing such communication services, as approved by the State Corporation Commission of Kansas; together with any amendments or successive issues thereof and makes itself a party to such access tariffs.

The Company hereby expressly reserves the right to cancel this statement of concurrence in whole or in part, at any time when it appears that such cancellation is in the best interest of the Company, subject to the jurisdiction of the State Corporation Commission of Kansas as it applies.

The Company may also enter into contracts for intrastate access service tailored to the specific needs of a limited number of individual customers with rates, terms and conditions that differ from those set forth in this tariff. Such contracts will be individually negotiated and take into account the nature of the facilities and services, the costs of construction and operation, the volume of traffic, and the length of service commitment by the customer. However, unless otherwise specified in the contract, the terms, conditions, obligations and regulations set forth in this tariff shall be incorporated into, and become a part of, said contract, and shall be binding on the customer. The Company may file the contract with the Kansas Corporation Commission and, if permitted by the Kansas Corporation Commission, all customer specific information will be redacted and be accompanied by a confidential non-redacted cover letter.

II. INTRASTATE SPECIAL ACCESS

The Company concurs in Rural Telephone Service, Inc. Intrastate Special Access, particularly in the rates, rules and regulations governing such communication services, as approved by the State Corporation Commission of Kansas; together with any amendments or successive issues thereof and makes itself a party to such access tariffs until this concurrence is revoked or cancelled. The Company hereby expressly reserves the right to cancel this statement in whole or in part, at any time when it appears that such cancellation is in the best interest of the company, subject to the jurisdiction of the State Corporation Commission of Kansas as it applies.

Exceptions:

A. Terms and Pricing

Term Pricing Plan (TPP) provides the customer with rate stabilization and discounted tariff rates. The customer agrees to a minimum monthly revenue commitment when establishing service under TPP.

Decrease in TPP monthly recurring tariff rates will be passed on to customers who participate in a TPP.

Should the Company increase its rates during the TPP period, the customer would continue to pay the rates in effect at the time the customer elected to establish service under TPP.
