STAFF'S MOTION TO WAIVE CIVIL FINE

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its Motion requesting the Commission waive the civil fine in Penalty Order issued to Legacy Christian Church (Carrier). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
- Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation
 (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 575309.
- 3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,139a and K.A.R. 82-4-30a, motor carriers operating interstate commerce must pay Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees annually, by January 1, each year. Carrier failed to pay its annual UCR fees for 2024 and 2025 as required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a.
- 4. On July 3, 2025, the Commission issued Penalty Order to Carrier. The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$300 civil fine for failing to pay its 2024 and 2025 UCR fees. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.

- 5. On July 8, 2025, Carrier contacted Staff regarding the Penalty Order and Carrier's unpaid UCR fees. Carrier stated that it is involved in the private transportation of passengers and therefore is not required to pay UCR fees.
 - 6. Staff confirmed that Carrier's operations do not require payment of UCR fees.
- 7. Based on the information provided, Staff asks the Commission to waive the \$300 civil fine ordered by the July 3, 2025, Penalty Order.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order waiving the \$300 civil fine in the Penalty Order issued July 3, 2025.
