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**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CLOSING DOCKET**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Prehearing Officer finds and concludes as follows:

1. On November 22, 2017, Trans Pacific Oil Corporation (Applicant) filed an Application for a well location exception and the assignment of a full allowable for the J. William Unit #3-29 well in Logan County, Kansas, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-108 and 82-3-203.<sup>1</sup>

2. On December 13, 2017, Ilene Rose, Trustee of the Rose Family Trust UTI 6/29/06 and Ilene Rose, Trustee of the Rose Survivor's Trust UTI 6/29/06 (collectively Protestants) filed a protest in the docket alleging that granting the application will detrimental to the Protestants' correlative rights and cause waste.<sup>2</sup>

3. On March 8 and 9, 2018 respectively, Garrett and Company Resources, LLC (Garret & Co.) filed a Petition to Intervene and an Amended Petition to Intervene. No Party filed a response to the Petition to Intervene.

4. On April 3, 2018, Jeff Kennedy entered an appearance on behalf of Delbert Rose.
5. On April 16, 2018, the Applicant filed a Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule.
6. On April 26, 2018, the Commission granted Garret & Co. intervention in the docket, granted the Applicant's Motion to Modify the Procedural Schedule and designated a Prehearing Officer in accordance with K.S.A. 77-551(c) to address any scheduling or procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b).
7. On May 2, 2018, the Applicant filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Application. The Applicant stated that all Parties to the docket had been consulted and indicated their consent to the withdrawal of the Application and closing the docket by signing the pleading.<sup>3</sup>
8. The Parties have appeared to come to amicable resolution the result of which is the withdrawal of the application. Therefore, there is no need for further Commission action. Pursuant to the Prehearing Officer's delegation under K.S.A. 77-551(c) to handle procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b), the Prehearing Officer finds that the dockets should be closed, and therefore grants the Operator's request.

**THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:**

- A. Docket No. 18-CONS-3240-CWLE shall be closed.
- B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
