### PETITION TO INTERVENE OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") respectfully requests that the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission") grant it leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of its petition, KCP&L offers the following:

- 1. On August 29, 2014, in accordance with the Commission's December 9, 1992 Order in Docket No. 163,561-U, Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation ("WCNOC") filed on behalf of KCP&L, Kansas Gas and Electric Company and Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. the 2014 Decommissioning Cost Study for the Wolf Creek Generating Station and the estimates of total capital costs for the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI), in accordance with the Commission's June 13, 2013 order in Docket No. 13-WCNE-204-GIE.
- 2. KCP&L is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, and is located at 1200 Main Street, Kansas City, Missouri. It is engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution and sale of electric energy. KCP&L distributes and sells electric service to the public in its certificated areas in the States of Kansas and Missouri, and is a "public utility" subject to the jurisdiction, supervision and control of the Commission under

Chapter 66 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated. KCP&L also is a transmission owning member of the Southwest Power Pool.

- 3. As a co-owner of the Wolf Creek Generating Station, KCP&L has a direct interest in this proceeding that cannot adequately be represented by any other party. Allowing KCP&L to intervene at this time will not prejudice any party to the proceeding and will not impair the orderly conduct thereof.
