We are writing you in regard to the Notice of Filing Application letter from the Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas concerning the request from Eastern Kansas Operating, LLC to perform vacuum operation of one well on the Fischer Lease located in section 21, Township 16 South, Range 25 East, Miami County, Kansas. We **dispute** the Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas from granting the ability to perform the vacuum of one well.

Listed below are our concerns about the application mailed to us and the adjoining property owners:

1. Loss of our individual property owner correlative rights
2. Destruction to our property from the vacuum operation process
3. Loss of property values due to operations
4. Concern of disposal of waste water from well and environmental impacts
5. Certificate of Service is incorrect as it lists the wrong Exhibit and appears to exclude many other property owners surrounding my property
6. Exhibit B which is a map does not follow the State of Kansas Guidelines and is blank
7. Current noise levels from wells already floods our neighborhood and disrupts wildlife and other outdoor activities
8. Lack of maintenance on the current well
9. Future noise levels generated from more wells will have a further impact on our way of life and have a higher level of disruption for the wildlife and outdoor activities
