Dear Executive Director:

Please accept for filing the following KCC tariffs, issued on this date, October 15, 2024, to be effective on November 1, 2024, by Gregory L. Brown, General Manager of Jayhawk Pipeline, L.L.C. These tariff rates are increased to account for the FERC Order #RM20-14-003 Reinstating Index Level for 2024.

On May 14, 2021, FERC issued its Notice of Annual Change in the Producer Price Index for Finished Goods, 175 FERC ¶ 61,117 (2021), which established the index adjustment applicable to the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. This Notice was amended by FERC on May 17, 2021, through an Errata Notice, clarifying the index adjustment applicable to this period was 0.994188. Subsequently, on January 20, 2022, FERC issued a Notice of Change in Oil Pipeline Index Figure. According to the Notice, the index adjustment applicable to the period March 1, 2022, through June 30, 22 is 0.984288. Additionally, on September 17, 2024, FERC issued an Order Reinstating Index Level, allowing Pipeline's to recompute ceiling levels pursuant to section 342.3(e) of the Commission's regulations. In accordance with the Notice, Jayhawk Pipeline, L.L.C. is filing KCC Tariff Nos. 79, 80, 81, 82, and 83 in compliance with the provisions of 18 CFR § 342.3 (Indexing). Also attached as the justification, as required by 18 CFR § 342.3(b), is a schedule of the rates to be changed, specifying proposed new rates, prior rates, prior ceiling levels and applicable ceiling levels.

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 341.14 (Special Permission), Jayhawk requests that it be granted a waiver under Section 6(3) of the ICA to file F.E.R.C. Nos. 37.14.0, 39.12.0, 40.12.0, and 41.7.0 on 16 days' notice, so that they may become effective on November 1, 2024. The requested waiver is sought in recognition of the Commission's September 17, 2024, Order on Reinstating Index Level, which stated that "[t]o the extent that pipelines are unable to submit these filings 30 days, pipelines may seek waiver of the 30-day notice requirement." Consistent with this request, Jayhawk acknowledges that these tariff publications are conditionally accepted, subject to refund, pending a 30-day review period.

Jayhawk Pipeline, L.L.C. has served notification of the tariff issuance on or before the issuance date to all shippers that Jayhawk serves in Kansas. Upon approval by the Kansas Corporation Commission, Jayhawk will make these tariff documents available on a website at: http://www.chspipelines.com.
