ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CLOSE DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On February 14, 2017, Commission Staff (Staff) sent a Notice of Denial of License Renewal Application to Marco Wind Operations, LLC (Applicant).¹ The application was “denied pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155(c)(4) because you and other partners appear to be associated with entities that are not in compliance with Commission statutes, regulations, and orders.” Specifically, Staff alleged that either Mr. Savage or his partners were associated with the following entities:

- a. K.C. Development, Inc. License #3011, which has unplugged wells on its expired, suspended license and has not complied with the Commission’s Default Order in Docket 16-CONS-3813-SHO; and
- b. CAT Energy, LLC, License #32778, which has unplugged wells on its expired license.

2. On February 14, 2017, the Operator filed a request for hearing with the Commission.²

3. On March 16, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference.³

4. On May 12, 2017, Staff filed a Motion to Close Docket which stated, "All matters have been resolved to the satisfaction of Staff, which no longer wishes to contest Operator's license renewal application. Staff has processed the application, and Operator's license has been renewed."⁴ Staff requested the docket be closed.

5. Based on Staff's affirmation to the Commission that all matters have been appropriately resolved, the Commission grants Staff's Motion to Close Docket.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Staff's Motion to Close Docket is granted.


B. Parties have 15 days, plus three days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration.⁵
