STAFF'S MOTION TO VACATE PENALTY ORDER

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its Motion requesting the Commission reinstate the Kansas motor carrier operations as well as vacate the Penalty Order issued to Hotrods Transport LLC (Carrier). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
- Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation
 (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 3885535.
- 3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,139a and K.A.R. 82-4-30a, motor carriers operating interstate commerce must pay Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees annually, by January 1, 2024. Carrier failed to pay its annual UCR fees by January 1, 2024, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a.
- 1. On September 10, 2024, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations, ¹ due to non-compliance with a Penalty Order issued in this docket on July 11, 2024. ² The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$300 civil fine for its failure to pay its 2024

UCR fees by January 1, 2024, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367-40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.

- 4. On September 18, 2024, Carrier contacted Staff stating that Carrier does not operate and requesting in writing that its USDOT Number be inactivated. Staff inactivated Carrier's USDOT Number and determined the carrier had not operated in interstate commerce and therefore Carrier's Penalty Order should be vacated.
- 5. Based on the information provided, Staff asks the Commission to vacate the penalty order as the Carrier did not operate interstate.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order vacating the penalty order issued July 11, 2024.
