**SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION**

COMES NOW Quito, Inc. ("Applicant"), and supplements its original Application previously filed herein with the following additional information:

1. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Applicant has experienced a field labor shortage. The labor shortage prevents Applicant from placing the Solomon Lease back into operation at this time.
2. The number and types of wells on the lease are: 3 production wells; 4 injection wells.
3. The estimated cost to plug the Solomon #2 Well is \$2,000.00. The estimated cost to plug the remaining wells on the lease is \$2,000.00 each.
4. There is no current production; the lease is held by payment of agreed minimum royalty.
5. There has been no estimation made of remaining reserves; however, the Solomon Lease has produced in excess of 26,000 barrels of oil after 1983, and Applicant

believes there are substantial oil reserves remaining and producible. The Solomon #2 Well is located in an in-field location.

6. Recent activity has occurred on this well. When the Applicant initially attempted to test the casing integrity of the Solomon #2 Well, a hole in the casing above surface was discovered. A casing repair was completed and the well successfully passed a Casing Integrity Test.

7. If Applicant decides to use the Solomon #2 for injection, the estimated cost to convert the well for that purpose is \$1,000.00. If the Solomon #2 is placed back into production, the estimated cost to re-equip and place back into operation is \$2,000.00.

WHEREFORE Applicant prays for the relief requested in its initial Application.
