ENTRY OF APPEARANCE AND PETITION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW, The Kansas Farm Bureau ("KFB" or "Intervenor"), and respectfully requests to intervene in the above-captioned case pursuant to K.S.A. 77-521 and K.A.R. 82-1-225. In support of its petition, Intervenor states and alleges as follows:

- 1. On August 3, 2023, the Kansas Corporate Commission ("KCC") filed an Order Opening General Investigation in this matter.
- 2. KFB is organized in Kansas under the Cooperative Marketing Act. Established in 1919, KFB's mission is to strengthen agriculture and the lives of Kansans through advocacy, education, and service. KFB has over 106,000 members in all 105 counties in Kansas, of which members, over 30,000 are farmers and ranchers, owning and operating on land in rural Kansas. KFB represents producers across all sectors of Kansas agriculture.
- 3. Intervenor serves the agricultural industry and is one of the main trade associations representing Kansas farmers and ranchers. The organization functions to advocate

for its members in many different forums. In the energy space, specifically, the Intervenor has participated in matters before the KCC, FERC, and the Kansas Legislature.¹

- 4. In Kansas, there are 45,759,319 acres of farmland, which accounts for 87.5% of all Kansas land.² More than 21 million acres in Kansas is harvested for crops and over 14 million is pastureland for grazing animals.³ As the largest class of landowners and operators in the state, Kansas' farmers and ranchers are greatly impacted by transmission lines crossing the countryside.
- 5. The representation of the Intervenor's interests, and the interests of its members, by existing parties is or may be inadequate.
- 6. "The general criteria governing intervention is set by statute and in the Commission's rules and regulations, specifically K.S.A. 77-521 and K.A.R. 82-1-225." "These authorities provide the Commission considerable discretion regarding intervention, essentially allowing the Commission to grant intervention if it is determined that the request was made in

the interest of justice and will not delay the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceeding."5

7. The intervenor respectfully submits to this Commission that neither the interests of justice, nor the prompt and orderly conduct of these proceedings will be impaired by granting and permitting its intervention in this docket.

8. If permitted to intervene, KFB will strive to participate in a meaningful way, as a voice for its landowner members, for the thorough investigation into the principles and priorities to be established for evaluating the reasonableness of the location of a proposed transmission line in future line siting proceedings.

9. As mentioned above, KFB has previously been granted the opportunity to intervene in another matter before the Commission.⁶

10. WHEREFORE, Intervenor therefore requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene in this docket and to participate in this docket in a manner that would provide the right to conduct discovery, file pleadings and testimony, present oral argument, and participate in any scheduled hearings as needed and on a limited basis.
