

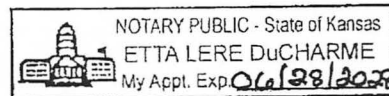

James Everett Keener, 82, passed away Friday June 28, 2024 in Wichita Kansas. Born in La Crosse, Kansas, lived in Nakoma, Kismet. Graduating from Mullinville High School, 1960, graduating from Pratt community college, 1962, and graduating from Wichita State University, 1967. Served in the United States Peace Corps 1967-69. You are hereby notified that TGT Petroleum Corporation ("Applicant") has filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission") requesting an exception to the ten-year temporary abandonment time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111(b) for Gary Wm #5 oil well located approximately 1,493' FSL and 3,917' FEL of Section 6-T28S-R18W, Kiowa County, Kansas.

The application is pending with the Commission.
